Learners will be able to explain to patients with tendinitis, neuroma or painful scar, the rationale for prolotherapy, risk and benefit and requirements in local injection with dilute sclerosing solution or with methyprednisolone, and perform these safely and effectively.

SEPTEMBER 24TH 2024 SPINAL CORD STIMULATION

Learners will be able to select patients with intractable pain for appropriate referral for spinal cord stimulation, and identify those for whom it is inappropriate, will be able to instruct them regarding risk and benefit, and aftercare and concurrent care.

PAIN AND SYMPTOMS MANAGEMENT

Learners will be asked to bring examples of cases that have been challenging.

Learners will learn an approach to interviewing and examining difficult/chronic patients, guided interviews to identify coping strategies and current psychosocial challenges, teaching patients to set short-term reachable goals, and frequent follow-up and support to guide patients' progress, and teaching patients to correctly appraise their progress, while giving positive reinforcement.

PHARMACOGENOMICS

Learners to be able to discuss/explain to patients drug-gene testing, current pharmacogenic testing benefits and requirements, to integrate knowledge, and to explain/manage pain/mental health issues and self-care.
